“Bucks County Farmhouses”

The meeting will feature a lecture by Jeffrey L. Marshall, NHA Board Member and Vice President of Resource Protection for the Heritage Conservancy, on his recently published book entitled, “Bucks County Farmhouses.” The book is a 136 page photo essay that traces the various types of farmhouses built in the county prior to the Civil War Era. While the book devotes a number of pages on log houses and brick houses, the majority of the book focuses on the iconic Bucks County Stone Farmhouse in its many variations and forms.
