“Save Our Steel: The Redevelopment of
Bethlehem Steel”

The November meeting of the **Newtown Historic Association** will be held on **Monday, November 20th at 8:00 PM at the Court Inn**, Court St. & Centre Ave., Newtown.

“Save Our Steel: The Redevelopment of Bethlehem Steel” will be presented by Amey Senape and Mike Kramer, historians and preservationists who formed the grassroots organization “Save Our Steel” in 2003 to advocate the historically sensitive redevelopment of the former Bethlehem Steel plant in Bethlehem, PA. The short documentary video “Homestead: From Mill to Mall” will be shown which was aimed at educating Bethlehem's citizens and elected officials about the value of preservation and sustainable community development. The film explores the consequences of uncontrolled commercial redevelopment of US Steel’s former flagship plant, the “Homestead Works,” and offers suggestions to Bethlehem for its steel mill redevelopment.
